



### **\*\*\*LJT 2021 Update\*\*\***

After 29 months without a LJT Fest, we are very excited to welcome you all back to The Mountain in just a few weeks!

Like many other music venues, schools, amateur and professional sports facilities, and rodeo arenas that are opening their doors to large crowds this Fall, we intend to move forward with caution. We will continue monitoring COVID-19 conditions in our community, and we maintain regular communication with our county officials. With the increased level of protection shown to be provided by the vaccines, if you are considering a vaccination and feel it is right for you, we encourage you to do so. For those who choose to attend an event with large crowds such as LJT Fest but have not been vaccinated, we encourage you to take additional precautions such as wearing a mask, additional hand washing and social distancing.

We are committed to providing ways for everyone to remain safe so that we can all enjoy a #SAFELJT. Of course, as with any public gathering, there are known risks related to exposure to Covid-19, and all who attend the Larry Joe Taylor Texas Music Festival voluntarily assume those risks. But the good news is, LJT is one of the largest outdoor live music events in Texas and our venue is naturally equipped with a well-ventilated atmosphere and enough space to socially distance if you would like to. Additionally, we have taken enhanced health and safety measures for you, our artists, and staff, which include:

- On-site EMS station and medical team
- Daily temperature checks on staff
- Sanitizer stations and free masks available throughout the venue
- We encourage everyone to consider getting vaccinated
- We ask those who feel sick with any of the COVID-19 symptoms stay at home
- We encourage those who are not vaccinated to wear a mask
- We are moving all previously scheduled smaller concerts such as the Bloody Mary Mornings, the Saturday after party, and any welcome jams outdoors or to a more ventilated location
- Posted precautionary warnings and instructions throughout the venue

We know many of you are long term festival attendees and others plan on joining us for the first time this year, and we look forward to seeing all of you in September.
